Florida Student Assistance Grant Program Requirements and Guidelines

The Florida Student Assistance Grant (FSAG) Program is a need-based grant program available to resident, undergraduate students, who demonstrate substantial financial need and are enrolled in participating postsecondary institutions.

- The student will demonstrate financial need by completing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) www.fafsa.ed.gov, in time to be processed error-free, received by 5 pm, Friday, May 27, 2022.
- Be a Florida resident and a U.S. citizen or eligible non-citizen. A student's residency and citizenship status are determined by the postsecondary institution.
- Not owe a repayment or be in default under any state or federal grant, loan or scholarship program unless satisfactory arrangements to repay have been made.
- Not have previously received a baccalaureate degree.
- Enroll for a minimum of 12 credit hours per term for full-time, 9 credit hours for three-quarter-time; or 6 credit hours for half-time enrollment or 360 clock hours per term.
- Meet Florida's general eligibility requirements for receipt of state aid.
- Submit completed Admissions Application with Application
- Application and Financial Aid Application must be completed to be considered.
